

## Anthony O. Dell

Anthony Orville Dell of Hill Valley died at the J. C. Blair Memorial Hospital, Huntingdon, at 5:30 p. m. Saturday, November 10, 1956. He had been ill for several years.

Mr. Dell was born in Hill Valley on November 27, 1885, a son of Henry S. and Sarah (Bard) Long. He was united in marriage to Jennie M. Baker of Hill Valley on December 12, 1907, by the Rev. M. L. Collier, pastor of the Bedford Lutheran Church. Mrs. Dell died on May 12, 1950.

The deceased was a member of the Singers Gap Methodist Church and attended regularly as long as his health permitted. He had lived in the Hill Valley vicinity his entire life and attended lower Hill Valley Schools. He was a carpenter.
