

HIRAM B. SHANE DIED ON SUNDAY

HAD BEEN A RESIDENT OF BELVIDERE FOR MANY YEARS AND WAS WIDELY KNOWN AND ESTEEMED — FUNERAL TUESDAY AFTERNOON.

Hiram B. Shane passed away on Sunday afternoon at 2:45 o'clock, at the family residence, 1010 Whitney street.

The funeral services will be held at the house on Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. Dr. H. E. Rompel, pastor of the M. E. church, will conduct the services. The burial will be in the Belvidere cemetery.

The deceased had been afflicted for many years with a trouble of an asthmatic nature, but had been confined to his bed for only the last three weeks. He was 77 years of age on the 10th of last October.

There survive of the immediate family the wife, one son, Harry B. Shane, who has been caring for his father for the last two weeks, and one daughter, Mrs. Fletcher Perlett, both of this city. A son, Fred, passed away January 13, 1910, and three children died in infancy.

Mr. Shane was born in West Virginia and was six months of age when his parents came west and settled in Peoria. The deceased and his family moved to this city in 1876 and have occupied the same house which is now the family residence since that time.

The longtime citizen was a man of most estimable character and had the respect and confidence of the large number of friends made in his extended residence here. Their sympathies will be extended in great measure to those called to bear the burden of bereavement and sorrow.
